This contest is open to any girl or boy in Hocking County and meets the age requirements per category. Girl contestants aged 5 will compete in Tiny Miss Hocking County Fair Category. Boy contestants aged 5 will compete in Tiny Mister Hocking County Fair. Girl contestants ages 6-7 years old will compete in Little Miss Hocking County Fair. Boy Contestants ages 6-7 years old will compete in Little Mister Hocking County Fair. All contestants must be between the ages listed by January 1, 2025.

The application form, an attached photo, plus a \$10.00 entry fee Must be turned into the Hocking County Fair Secretaries office during entry times of Friday Aug. 1st from 4:00pm-7:00pm, Saturday Aug. 2nd from 9:00am-4:00pm; Friday Aug. 15th from 4:00pm-7:00pm or can be mailed to the Hocking County Fair P.O. Box 142, Logan Ohio 43138 by the deadline of Friday August 15th. Mailed entries must be postmarked by Monday Aug. 11<sup>th</sup>. No metered postmarks will be accepted.

Contestants will meet on Saturday, August 16, 2025, in the Art Hall for their interviews and pictures. Parents must leave when interviews begin. Contestants will be judged on their poise, personality, and their ability to talk to the judges. Each contestant will have an individual interview in no particular order. They should be ready to answer questions from their application, they should dress nicely. Girls are not permitted to wear pageant dresses.

Contestants must be present for both the interview and the coronation to be selected as a winner. Contestants must meet at the Show Arena on Sunday September 7, 2025, by 6:45 PM. To line up for the contest. Photographs of winners from each category will take place after each age category of winners are announced. There will be a top winner, three attendants and congeniality for each category. Winners will not be given any duties during the fair but are encouraged to wear their royalty attire when they visit the fair.
